## **Terms and Conditions**

## ENTRY TO THIS AWARENESS CUM ACADEMIC PROGRAM CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES.

- Program: In order to enter this online Master Mentor Geo-Enabling Indian Scholars (MMGEIS) Program, 2023 ('Program'), you must agree to these terms and conditions ('T&Cs'). Therefore, please read these T&Cs prior to submitting your application for the Program, (as defined below) to ensure you understand and agree to them. The Program is organized by Centre of Knowledge Sovereignty (CKS) and Esri India Technologies Private Limited ('Esri India') (collectively referred as 'Organizer'). You agree that submission of an application in the Program constitutes agreement to these T&Cs. Unless you agree to these T&Cs, you may not submit an application to the Program and are not eligible to receive the mentoring described in these T&Cs. These T&Cs form a binding legal agreement between you and the Organizer (as defined below) with respect to the Program.
- 2. Eligibility: This Program is open to school students from 8th to 12th standards and undergraduate college students, in India ('Students'). The major Students (i.e. 18 years and above age) can participate directly whereas, in case of minor Students (i.e. less than 18 years of age) the participation in the Program shall be through Parents/ Guardians/ School. Application shall be submitted online using the form link available on www.mmgeis.in ('Website').
- 3. Application Guidelines: Students who are eligible need to:
  - a) There shall be no registration fees for the Program.
  - b) Students shall register for the Program online on the Website. No other form of application will be accepted.
  - c) Along with registration, for minors, a consent form by the Parent/Guardian/School to be submitted, as applicable. The template for same needs to be downloaded from the online form on the Website.
  - d) On registration, the students will receive an auto-generated acknowledgement mail in their inbox stating the receipt of the registration form.
  - e) The submitted registration form will be reviewed by the Organizer. In case of the information is found incomplete, the Student maybe contacted to complete the same. An incomplete or incorrect application will be rejected without any intimation at the sole discretion of Organizer.
  - The applications should be submitted within the period as maybe notified on the Website from time to time.
- . Mentorships: Highlights of the Program are as follows:
  - A) Maximum No. of registered candidates: 1,00,000 per batch
  - B) Relevant updates of the Program will be published on the Website from time to time.
  - C) The Program may have 3 stages for school students and 4 stages for Undergraduates. At each stage, the students will have to appear for an online examination. The online examination will select the students (as per their rank) who will be invited for the next stage.
  - D) After successful completion of all stages of the Program, as applicable, winners may be announced by the Organizer.
  - E) Organizer reserves the right to withdraw, change the value or cancel the winning prizes or change the prizes pre-announced, at its sole discretion.
- . Judging and notification of results: The Students will be judged on the below parameters:
- A) Organizer will notify the Student on the updates of the Program and results etc. on the email id registered under the Program. The Organizer will not be responsible in case the Student does not receive or acted upon the communication.
- B) Final selection will be done on the basis of the results of the exams and judgement of the Jury.
- c) The decision of the Jury with regard to the selection of winners will be final and non-appealable.
- 6.
